- Students can earn Tiger Tokens for good choices in class and out of the classroom. These Tiger Tokens come into play with our classroom economy and school wide rewards.
- Students can buy coupon for special rewards such as free dress pass, jean day pass, homework pass, and even \$5 gift cards or movie passes.
- Students can also save their Tiger Tokens for end of the year tiger market. Students can buy toys and other rewards. This Tiger Market will happen at the end of the year.
