

Class Dojo

- Class Dojo is a communication app where we can share pictures, videos, and student work and communicate directly. I have used this app for years and love it!
- We can also communicate directly or as a whole class with parents and caregivers.
- The intro letter to Class Dojo was sent home the 2nd day of school. Please let us know if you need another access code in order to log on.
- Once you download the app you can establish an account for yourself and your child.
- Students can change their Class Dojo avatar as they wish.

Homework

- Homework will be handed out every Friday and is due the following Thursday. Homework will be sent home in the book bags. If you did not return a signed book bag release form, your child will receive their homework stapled.
- Homework is very similar week to week. Each day will consist
 of Sight Word Practice, Language Arts Worksheet and a Math
 worksheet.
- A reading log is part of the homework packet. Reading logs are expected to be completed nightly and returned with homework packets on Thursdays.
- Students will receive Tiger Tokens for completing their Homework.

Aftendance and Truancy

- It is important that you child only miss school if they are ill or due to family emergencies.
- We will begin class at 8:10am.
- Students are expected to be in line and on their number by 8:05am. Mrs. Medina was unable to pick up students earlier than this during the first full week of school, but this is the regular time she picks them up.
- Students are late if they arrive to the classroom
 after 8:10. If you are tardy, or even suspect that you
 might be tardy, please stop by the office for a tardy slip.
 This will be strictly enforced.
- Parents and students should not linger in the hallways in the morning.
 Everyone needs to be out on the play yard.
- Our day ends at 2:30pm.

Every Wednesday is a minimum day and students are dismissed at 1:10pm.



Volunteers

- All volunteers are required to have a TB test, give fingerprints, and be approved through the district. Applications can be picked up in the office.
- In class, volunteers are always welcome, but we ask that during the first weeks of school parents allow our class to settle without their presence.
 This helps establish our routines and procedures.

If you cannot volunteer in the class, there are a variety of activities that can be sent home to help, such as cutting out or organizing documents weekly.

• We always need volunteers for field trips, so let us know as soon as possible if you can help during excursions and you have permission from the district.

 Our class also need a Booster Club Parent representative. This rep is required to attend all Booster Club meetings and help our grade level request approval for fundraising opportunities. They will be our contact person with the Booster Club.

Snack and Lunch

- Students have snack recess at <u>9:15 am and 1:15pm</u>.
 Students are encouraged to bring a SMALL healthy snack.
- Healthy snacks are encouraged. For example fruit, yogurt, cereal, and veggies are great snacks.
- NO Takis, Hot Cheetos or other spicy type of snacks please.
- Full size bags of chip are NOT allowed at school.
- Candy, cookies, and soda are NOT ALLOWED at school.
- Students can bring a bottle water to keep at their desks.
 Only water is allowed in these bottles.
- Lunch is at 10:30 am Mon. Tue. Thrs. and Fri.
- On Wed. Lunch is at 10:50am.
